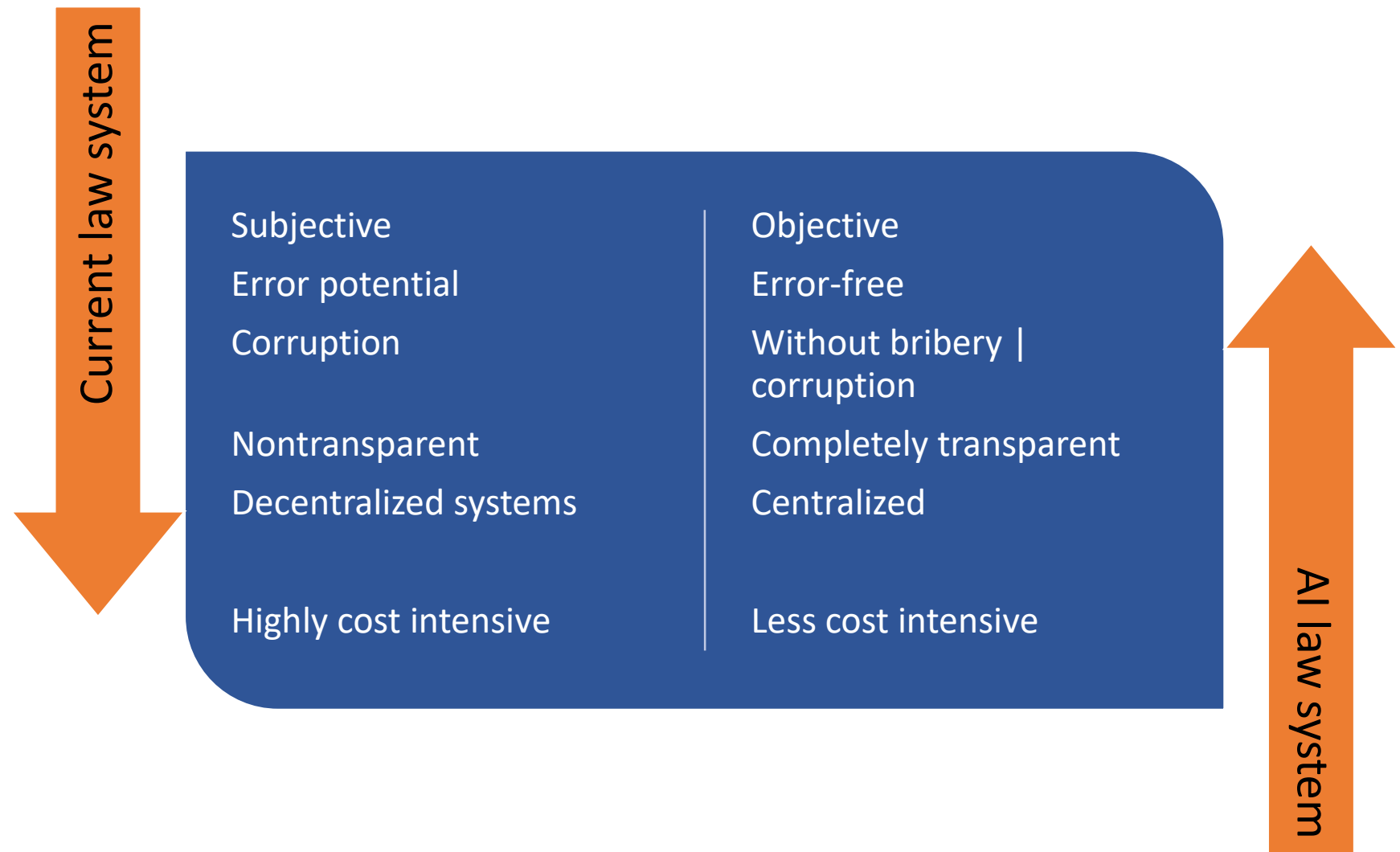
- should be objective instead of subjective

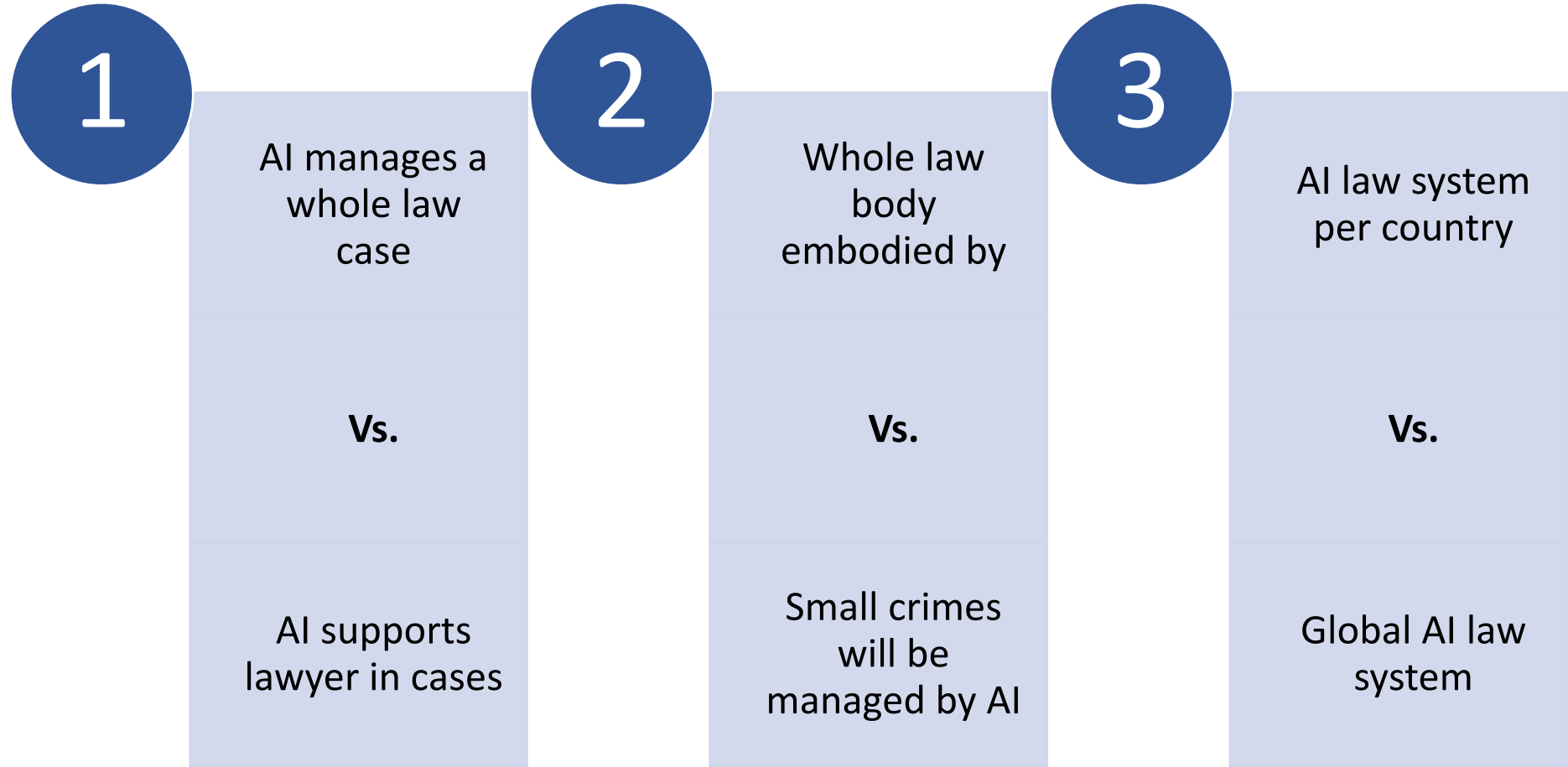

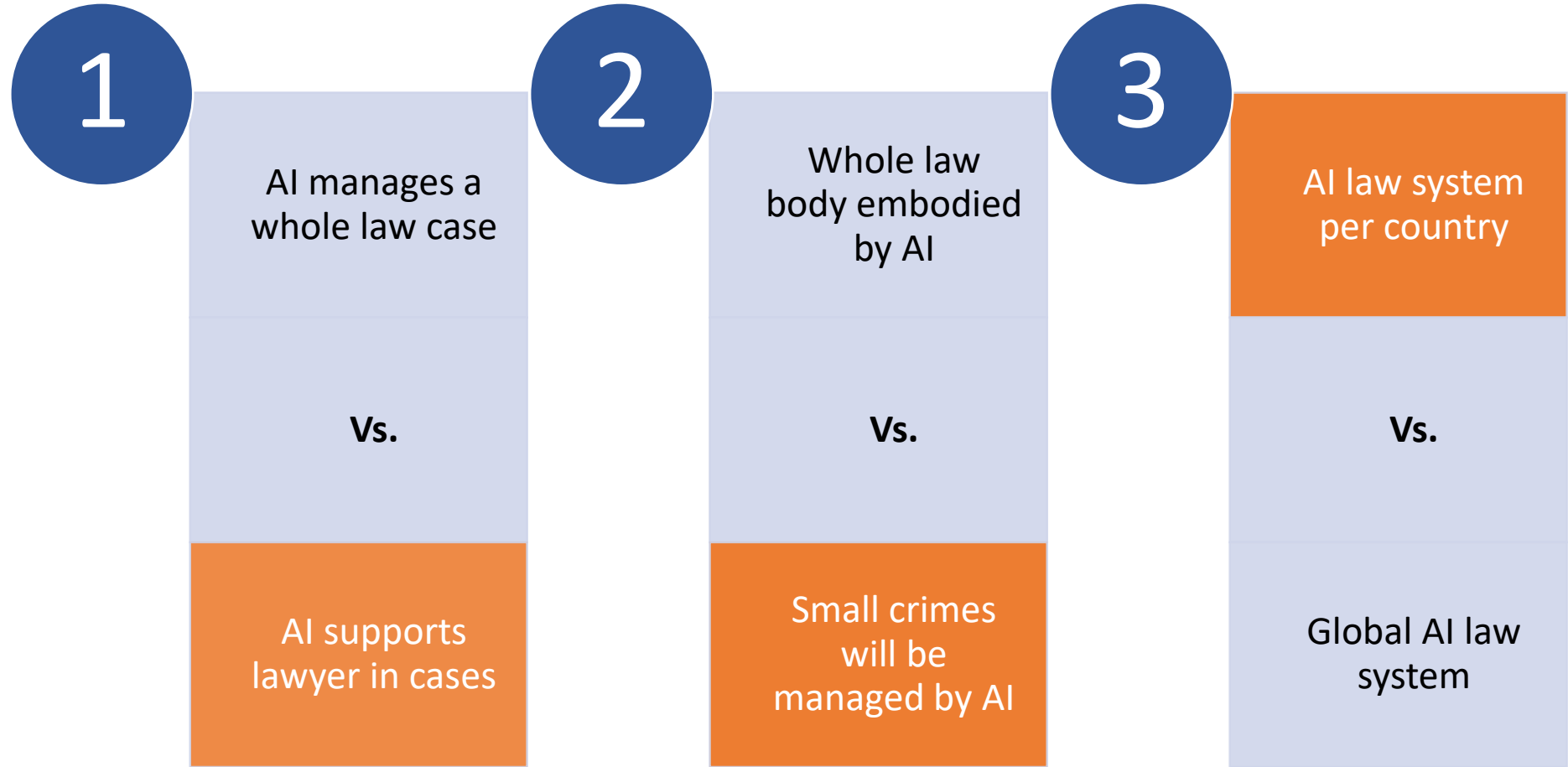

Industry reaction

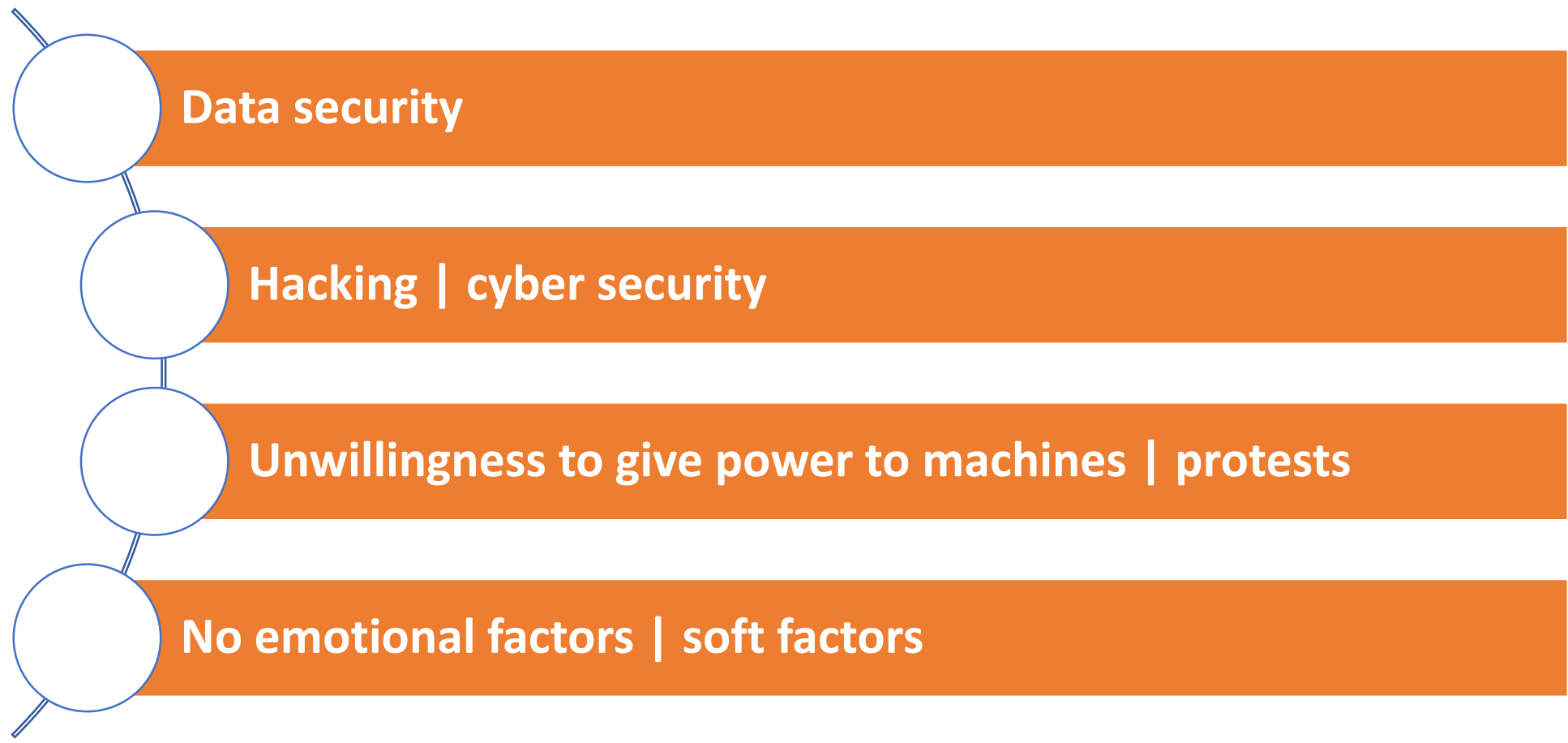
No or less lawyers needed BUT more IT specialists
