1. Why should I apply?

- The JMSB International Case Competition is the biggest case competition of its kind! 36 business schools from around the world battle it out in a showdown at Montreal's Hotel Bonaventure to find the ultimate winner. Judges and Sponsors are some of the biggest names in Canada with their backgrounds in varied industries and sectors. As a Volunteer, YOU get to be at the centre of it all. Apart from it being an excellent Networking and Resume building opportunity, you can also keep an eye out for some sweet perks!

If you are an MBA student or wish to pursue MBA in the future, a Lead Volunteer position can be especially beneficial for you. Being an organiser or EA counts to Experiential learning and you can get from 3-6 credits for managing that position for the next ICC. 2. Who can apply?

- Everyone who is 18+ is welcome to apply. You can be a working professional or a non-business student or just in between jobs and want to try out something new! Lots of students from other universities and colleges also volunteer with us every year. If you are motivated to apply and ready to learn and grow with this opportunity, Team eICC would be happy to have you!

3. How long is the commitment and if the competition is virtual, will I be working from home?

- We at the ICCC need a variety of volunteers who work for different departments. You can turn up for just one day or all 7. If you want a role that allows work from home or the one that lets you get your hands dirty in our war room; let us know, we can work it out. Please note that work from home roles are fewer than on-site ones, so be sure to apply soon.

If you are applying for the role of Lead Volunteer, you will have to be present during the whole week of the competition with us at Hotel Bonaventure.

4. Why are my resume, Linkedin and education details required?

- Beyond all the fun, JMSB MBA eICC is also a wonderful networking opportunity. Your resume and educational background are shared with our sponsors and judges who can reach out to you to recruit you for future career opportunities if you wish.

5. Is it mandatory to know French?

- While it is a bonus to know French especially for the role of Judge Coordinator, it is not mandatory.

6. What does the Lead Volunteer role entail?

-Lead Volunteers help recruit, train, and supervise other volunteers. They also assist the other organizers of ICC directly in executing department tasks on the days of the

competition. Lead Volunteers get first-hand experience of working for a department of their choice during the days of the event giving more credibility and weight to you application when you choose to apply.

Becoming a Lead Volunteer is also a great way to get to know the competition, the committee members, the staff all of which can greatly help if you plan to apply as an Organizer/ Executive Assistant next year.
